This year's conference will be held at the **Four Points by Sheraton Hotel** in London, Ontario. The hotel address is:

When registering, please be sure to call the hotel's direct line – not the Sheraton Hotels central reservations line. Be sure to mention "**COCA**" to receive the preferred COCA rate of \$135 per night, single or double occupancy – see "Hotel Room Rates" and "Hotel Brochure" – PDF's under "General Info" on this web page for more details. COCA's block of rooms is being held until Thursday, May 20th. Be sure to reserve your room well in advance so you are not disappointed. If you miss the cut-off date, the hotel should still honour the COCA rate as long as space is still available.

The Hotel has two restaurants and a lounge on the Main Lobby Level. These are: Tuscany's Ristorante (hot breakfast buffet & omelet bar every morning, a luncheon buffet and pasta bar Monday–Friday), and Bentley's Lounge (light-fare cuisine which is more for socializing over drinks).
