Central Sub-Regional Info/Brief
University of Windsor

When: Friday, March 26th, 2010 – Band Load-in will be from 5:30pm – 6:30pm (NO LATER) Doors 7:30pm - Show starts 8:00pm sharp!

Where: The Basement Pub, University of Windsor, Windsor

******All acts will be advanced more detailed instructions & directions to venue, hotels etc. once routing & number of participants is established ******

Who: The winners from approx 6 participating Central schools

Schedule: ONE MEMBER of each band is required to attend a pre-show meeting at 6:40 pm in the venue. The order of participants will be chosen at this meeting.

1st band goes on at 8 pm. All acts have a 20 min. set.

Bands will be given a “5 minutes left” warning signal. If you go more than a minute over-time, your monitors and the lights will be turned off and you WILL be shut down. Being shut off negatively impacts your final score.

Changeover times are only 10 minutes long, so everyone is expected to be respectful and cooperative with the bands before and after you. Stage right will be used for loading gear off the stage (and directly out of pub), and stage left will be used for loading gear to the stage to keep equipment from getting mixed up. (signs will be posted and stage crew available to assist). **There will be no sound checks!** Line checks will be done during your changeover time.

How it will work:

Space will be available for each band in the backstage area. **All bands must provide a stage plot by Wednesday March 24th @ 4:30pm.** They can be sent to Todd Shearon via email: tshearon@uwindsor.ca.

Full Back-line will be provided and but bands may choose to use their own backline if they prefer. Backline will consist of 1 standard 5 piece drum kit / 2 guitar amps / 1 bass rig. Guitar players may bring own pedals. Drummers must bring own breakables (snare / cymbals).

Each act must inform Todd Shearon (tshearon@uwindsor.ca) in advance whether they will be using the backline provided or if they will be bringing their own gear

All decisions of the Stage Manager are final.
