COCA National Campus Life Conference Bursary Program

COCA - the Canadian Organization of Campus Activities, is pleased to announce the availability of four (4) student bursaries to attend the 2018 COCA National Conference to be held June 12 - 16 in Fredericton, New Brunswick at the Delta Fredericton.

3 of the 4 bursaries will be allocated one each to the 3 COCA regions:

- Eastern Region (schools in New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, PEI and Newfoundland/Labrador)
- Central Region (schools in Quebec and Ontario)
- Western Region (schools from Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta and British Columbia)

The final bursary will be allocated to an indigenous student from the host conference region. (The 2018 COCA National Conference will be held in the eastern region).

ELIGIBILITY

All applicants must be:

- a registered Canadian college or university student
- an elected or hired student member of a Canadian campus student union or association
- returning to classes in September 2018

PROVISION

Each bursary provides:

- Conference delegate registration fee;
- Round-trip travel to the conference, including ground transportation; and,
- Shared accommodations at the contracted COCA National Conference hotel.

Each bursary also includes all meals offered as part of the COCA National Conference. All other costs will be the responsibility of the bursary recipient.

Travel will be booked at the best available economy class rate.

Complete applications must be received by COCA no later than Friday, April 20, 2018 to be eligible. Bursary recipients will be selected by a panel of COCA officials.

Bursary recipients will be notified by the end of business day (EST) Monday, April 30, 2018.
